Bible Versus

Deuteronomy 4:29 But from there you will seek the LORD your God, and you will find Him if you seek Him with all your heart and with all your soul.

Commentary – Why do we seek God’s face (his presence)?

God lays out his formula to heal our nation in 2 Chronicles 7:14 *“if My people who are called by My name will **humble themselves**, and **pray** and **seek My face**, and **turn from their wicked ways**, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land.”* God wants us to seek his face (his presence) so that we can have a close, personal, intimate loving relationship with him. God knows everything about us, and He want us to know and understand Him so that we will love, trust, and obey Him. In Ephesians 5:25-32 God contrasts His love (as a groom) for the church (as a bride) to a husband’s love for himself and his wife. Seeking God’s face should look and feel like a dating, wooing, relationship of a couple falling in love for the first time where they can’t get enough of each other. It’s through this close loving relationship that God hears us, vindicates us, and pour out his blessing on us. Psalms 24:5-6 Says, *“They will see blessing from the Lord and vindication from God their Savior. Such is the generation of those who seek him, who seek your face, God of Jacob.”*

How can we seek God's face (presence)

- **Reading God's word** - (2 Timothy 3:16, Revelation 1:3)
- **By Faith** – (Hebrews 11:6, Romans 3:21-22, Romans 1:17, Romans 5:1, Hebrews 11:1)
- **Worship** - (Matthew 18:20, Revelation 4:8, Revelation 4:10)
- **Obedience** - (Psalm 66:18, John 3:19-21, 1 Thessalonians 5:22, 1 John 5:3)
- **Loving Him and others** – (Matthew 22:36-39, Mark 12:30-31, 1 Peter 4:8)
- **Seeking & Asking** - (Matthew 7:7-8, Psalm 105:4, Proverbs 8:17, 1 Chronicles 16:10-11)
- **Believing Him** - (John 1:12, John 3:16=18, Romans 10:11, 1 John 5:13, Acts 16:31)
- **Trusting Him** – (Psalm 143:8, Proverbs 3:5-6, Psalm 9:10)
- **Give Thanks & Gratitude** - (1Thessalonians 5:18, 2 Corinthians 9:6-7)
- **Christ Centered Living** - (Matthew 6:31-33, Romans 12:1-2)
- **Praising Him** – (Psalm 50:23, 2 Chronicles 20:21, Psalm 63:3)
- **Fasting** – (Daniel 9:3, Matthew 6: 16-18, Esther 4:16)

Prayer Ideas

1. Pray that we recognize the need for a close, personal, intimate, loving relationship with God
2. Pray that we would present our bodies as living sacrifices to the Lord
3. Pray that we would not be conformed to this world, but to be transformed by the renewing of our minds
4. Pray that we as a nation would create a godly, nurturing society so our children and grandchildren can grow up knowing and loving God instead of the secular world
