Bible Verses

Psalms 82:4 Rescue the weak and the needy; deliver them from the hand of the wicked.

Matthew 18:10 See that you do not despise one of these little ones. For I tell you that in heaven their angels always see the face of my Father who is in heaven.

Ephesians 5:11 Take no part in the unfruitful works of darkness, but instead expose them.

Matthew 18:6 But whoever causes one of these little ones who believe in me to sin, it would be better for him to have a great millstone fastened around his neck and to be drowned in the depth of the sea.

Psalms 139:13-16 For you formed my inward parts; you knitted me together in my mother's womb. I praise you, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made. Wonderful are your works; my soul knows it very well. My frame was not hidden from you, when I was being made in secret, intricately woven in the depths of the earth. Your eyes saw my unformed substance; in your book were written, every one of them, the days that were formed for me, when as yet there was none of them.

Commentary – Pray for the children

2 Peter 1:3-4 His divine power has given us **everything we need** for a godly life through our knowledge of him who called us by his own glory and goodness. Through these **he has given us his very great and precious promises**, so that through them you may participate in the divine nature, having escaped the corruption in the world caused by evil desires.

As adults, we have the privilege and responsibility to care for children, pray for their protection and safety, and help children around us live the full and abundant life God desires for them. Sadly, love and security aren't the reality for children who suffer from sexual exploitation, child trafficking, and the horrifying results of gender confusion. Children as young as preschool are being exposed to materials promoting "gender fluidity." We must truly become prayer warriors. God has given us **everything we need** to do so. We can pray his **very great and precious promises** over these children and stand up for the Truth.

The following are some of the biblical instructions on how to pray

- Pray often (Ephesian 6:18, 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18, Romans 12:12)
- Pray for our leaders & enemies (1 Timothy 2:1-2, Luke 6:27-28, Mathew 5:44)
- Pray corporately (Mathew 18:19-20, Acts 2:42)
- Give God thanks (Psalm 69:30, Isaiah 25:1, 1 Thessalonians 5:18)
- Give God glory (Psalm 29:1-2, John 14:13, Revelation 14:7, Revelation 4:11)
- Ask in faith (Matthew 21:22, Mark 11:24, Psalm 69:13)
- Pray in God's will (1 John 5:14, James 4:3, Romans 8:27)
- Don't seek vengeance (Deuteronomy 32:35, Proverbs 20:22, Romans 12:19)
- Pray with perseverance (Galatian 6:9, Revelation 14:12, Hebrews 10:36)
- Prayers of intercession (James 5:16, Ephesians 6:18, 1 Timothy 2:1, Jeremiah 29:7)
- Pray for direction (James 1:5, Psalm 25:4-5, Matthew 7:7-8)

Prayer Ideas

1. Pray for our local, state, and national leaders to pass legislation protecting our children.
2. Pray for evil in our schools to continue to be revealed.
3. Pray for parents and leaders to stand strong against corruption in our schools.
4. Pray for parents to be able to make the best schooling choices for their kids.
5. Pray that the Church would speak boldly against the sexualization of children.
6. Pray for an end to child trafficking in the US and around the world.
7. Pray that election fraud and deceptive leaders would be revealed and that God would replace them with leaders focused on Truth.
8. Pray that more prayer warriors would rise and join the Eagle Forum prayer meeting and that we would have a Godly impact in our communities, Texas, the USA, and the world.
9. Pray that God would be gracious and merciful by intervening and bringing about a great revival in America.
10. Pray that millions of Americans will embrace 2 Chronicles 7:14 by humbling ourselves, praying, seeking God's face, and turning from our wicked ways so that He can forgive our sins and heal our land.
